DUOF is a wide-reaching, nonprofit organization, which secures additional resources from individuals, corporations, community organizations and other like-minded foundations to support its mission. Dynamic Urban Opportunities Foundation High School Academic Scholarship Details

The Dynamic Urban Opportunities Foundation High School Academic Scholarship consists of at least two \$3,000 non- renewable scholarships for female high school graduating seniors with academic achievement and community service. The purpose of the scholarship program is to encourage and enable female students of Black/African descent to attend college to achieve their future goals. Scholarship recipients should have a powerful desire to succeed, as well as meet all the requirements outlined below. **The complete application packet must be submitted for consideration.**

Scholarship Requirements

To be eligible for the Dynamic Urban Opportunities Foundation High School Academic Scholarship, each applicant must meet the following requirements:

- ✓ Must be a Black/African descent female student.
- ✓ Must be currently enrolled and attending as a full-time high school senior in King or Snohomish County with an expected graduation date no later than June 30 of the current year.
- Demonstrate academic achievement by having a minimum 2.7 GPA (on a 4.0 scale) upon high school graduation.
- Must be accepted and enrolled in an accredited four-year college or university for the upcoming academic year, beginning in September after June graduations.
- ✓ Must be Involved in at least one extracurricular, civic, community activity and /or employed while in high school,
- ✓ Possess leadership qualities.
- ✓ Show financial need.

Award Disbursements

The scholarship award will be paid to the recipients' college or university upon receipt of enrollment verification (student must provide address where funds should be sent as well as enrollment verification).

Application Process Timeline

All applications must be postmarked no later than April 15. Scholarship awardees will be notified by e-mail by May15, with additional information and further instructions for processing payment to your school.

Awardees of the scholarships are expected to attend an award ceremony in June and will be notified of the date, time and location as the event details are finalized for publication and ticket availability.

Dynamic Urban Opportunities Foundation High School Academic Scholarship Application Packet Guidelines

Each application packet <u>must</u> include the following information:

1. Completed Application Form

Applications must be typed or handwritten clearly. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.

2. Transcript

Applicants must send an **official transcript** from their high school with cumulative GPA listed (mailed transcripts must be **sealed and unopened**). You may have in lieu of mailing an official sealed transcript have your administrator email your transcript to <u>DUOFIncCom@gmail.com</u>. to the attention of the Scholarship Committee and it must be received for review by **April 15**.

3. Enrollment Verification

Applicants must provide proof of enrollment as a full-time student to an accredited four-year college or university for the upcoming fall academic year for payment to be issued (in all cases it must be provided prior to issuance of scholarship funds).

4. Recommendations

Applicants must submit two (2) letters of recommendation describing their character and potential from any of the following individuals:

High School Counselor, Current Teacher, Former Teacher or Counselor, Minister, Coach, Community Activity Director, Employer, etc.

These letters should be from individuals who can attest to your character, interpersonal relationships, and academic achievements and should not come from family members or peers. (*The electronic link and form is available on the DUOF website and must be completed by April 15*).

5. Essay

Applicants must submit a personal statement essay responding to the question in the application form.

6. US MAIL – We would prefer to receive the online submission form; however,we will accept complete paper applications postmarked by April 15. Send completed application packets by mail (postmarked no later than April 15)to:

Post Application Submissions

To receive the full disbursement of the scholarship award, recipients will be required to submit the following information no later than **October 31 this year**.

- Enrollment Verification: for the academic year including student ID number for payment assignment.
 - College/University Mailing Address: for the school recipient will attend.
